TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Technical Assistance Program (TAP) is a state-funded program which awards approximately \$23 million each year to expand free consulting and low-cost training services through federally and privately funded small business assistance centers. The program, launched in 2018, is focused on providing programming and outreach to underresourced small businesses, including women, minorities/people of color, and veteranowned businesses, and businesses in low-wealth, rural, and disaster-impacted communities. The program allocates funding through a competitive process.

APEX ACCELERATORS (FORMERLY PROCUREMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CENTERS (PTAC))

APEX Accelerators (formerly Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTACs)) provide a wide range of government contracting help — most free of charge! All PTACs are staffed with counselors experienced in government contracting and provide a wide range of services including classes and seminars, individual counseling and easy access to bid opportunities, contract specifications, procurement histories, and other information necessary to successfully compete for government contracts. Many PTAC counselors have backgrounds in government acquisitions and virtually all receive ongoing training to keep pace with continually evolving acquisitions procedures and policies.

SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTERS (SBDC)

Small business owners and aspiring entrepreneurs can go to their local SBDCs for FREE face-to-face business consulting and at-cost training on a variety of topics. The mission of America's nationwide network of SBDCs is to help new entrepreneurs realize the dream of business ownership, and assist existing businesses to remain competitive in an ever-changing global economy.

WOMEN'S BUSINESS CENTERS (WBC)
