PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The California Small Business and Nonprofit COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave Relief Grant Program is administered by CalOSBA through a competitive bid award to its intermediary, Lendistry, and its statewide network of community-based lenders and partners. The Program provides competitive micro grants ranging from \$5,000 to \$50,000 to eligible small businesses and nonprofits that provided COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave pursuant to the requirements of Sections 248.6 and 248.7 of the California Labor Code.

Round 1 closed June 28, 2023.
